MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH SERVICES BLOCK GRANT

The Maternal and Block funds are to be used:

To assure mothers and children (in particular those with low income or with limited availability of health services) access to quality maternal and child health services:

To reduce infant mortality and the incidence of preventable diseases and handicapping conditions among children, to reduce the need for inpatient and long-term care services, to increase the number of children (especially preschool children) appropriately immunized against disease and the number of low income children receiving health assessments and follow-up diagnostic and treatment services, and otherwise to promote the health of mothers and children (especially by providing preventive and primary care services for low income children, and prenatal, delivery, and postpartum care for low income mothers);

for \$1,107,795.87 par value GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS of the City, at which time and place such bids will be publicly opened. No oral or auction bids will be considered.

All of the Bonds will be negotiable coupon bonds, will be in denominations of \$5,000.00 each, except No. 1 in denomination of \$7,795.87, and the Bonds will be dated SEPTEMBER 1, 1982. The Bonds will mature serially in accordance with the following schedule:

Interest on the Bonds will first be payable on SEP-TEMBER 1, 1983, and thereafter semiannually on the first days of MARCH and SEPTEMBER in each year until the Bonds are fully paid. Both the principal of and interest on the Bonds will be payable to bearer at the Office of the State Treasurer in the City of Topeka, Kansas

Proposals will be received on the Bonds bearing such rate or rates of interest, not exceeding six (6) different interest rates, as may be specified by the bidder. The repetition of a rate will not constitute one of said maximum number of rates. The same rate shall apply to all Bonds of the same maturity. Each interest rate specified shall be in an even multiple of oneeighth (1/8th) or one-twentieth (1/20th) of One percent (1%). The difference between the highest and lowest coupon rates specified in any bid shall not exceed three percent (3%). No interest rate shall exceed the maximum interest rate allowed by Kansas Law; said rate being two percent (2%) above the Bond Buyer's 20 Bond Index, published in The Weekly Bond Buyer on Monday, August 9, 1982, and no bid of less than par and accrued interest will be considered. Bids involving the use of extra or supplemental coupons will not be considered. Bids for less than the entire issue of Bonds will not be considered.

All bids must state the total interest cost of the bid, the premium, if any, the net interest cost of the bid, and the average annual interest rate, all certified by the bidder to be correct; and the City will be entitled to rely on the certificate of correctness of the bidder. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check equal to Two percent (2%) of the total amount of the bid, and shall be payable to TREA-SURER, CITY OF DODGE CITY, KANSAS. In the event a bidder whose bid is accepted shall fail to carry out his Contract of Purchase, said deposit shall be retained by the City as liquidated damages. The checks of unsuccessful bidders will be returned promptly.

The Bonds, duly printed, executed and registered, will be furnished and paid for by the City; and the Bonds will be sold subject to the unqualified approving opinion of GAAR & BELL, Bond Counsel, of Wichita, Kansas, whose opinion will be paid for by the City. The purchaser will be furnished with a complete Transcript of Proceedings evidencing the authorization and issuance of the Bonds; and the usual closing proofs, which will include a Certificate that there is no litigation pending or threatened at the time of delivery of the Bonds affecting their validity. Delivery of the Bonds will be made to the successful bidder on or before SEPTEMBER 23, 1982, at any bank in the STATE OF KANSAS or KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, at the expense of the City. Delivery elsewhere will be made at the expense of the purchaser.

It is anticipated that CUSIP identification numbers will be printed on the Bonds; but neither the failure to print such numbers on any Bond or any error with respect thereto shall constitute cause for a failure by the successful bidder to accept delivery of and pay for the Bonds in accordance with the terms of its Contract and this Notice of Bond Sale. All expenses in connection with the printing of CUSIP numbers on the Bonds

shall be paid by the City.

The Bonds will constitute general obligations of the City, payable as to both principal and interest in part from the collection of special assessments which have been levied on benefited property; but any portion of said specially assessed part not so paid, and the remainder of said principal and interest will be payable from ad valorem taxes which may be levied without limitation as to rate or amount upon all of the taxable tangible property within the territorial limits of the City. The Bonds are being issued for the purpose of

various street improvements in the City.

The sealed bids for the Bonds shall be opened publicly and only at the time and place specified in this Notice; and the Bonds will be sold to the best bidder. The City reserves the right to reject any and/or all of the bids, and to waive any irregularities. OPINION NO. 82-164

Personal and Real Property—Conveyances of Land—Recordation of Instruments Affecting Real Estate. Samuel L. Schuetz, Brown County Attorney, Hiawatha, August 2, 1982.

A register of deeds is required to file of record a written instrument whereby real estate may be affected. Such filing can properly be refused only if the instrument contains apparent errors, or is not proved or acknowledged, and certified in the manner prescribed by law, or the register of deeds has been directed by a court not to file the instrument. Of course, a register of deeds also may refuse to file instruments that clearly do not affect real estate, or where the law requires some act, such as payment of the mortgage registration fee, before the instrument may be received and filed of record. OPINION NO. 82-165

Automobiles and Other Vehicles—Arrests, Citations, Procedures and Penalties—Appearance Bonds; Use of Credit Cards. Howard Schwartz, Judicial Administrator, Topeka, August 4, 1982.

Chapter 44 of the Laws of 1980 amended K.S.A. 8-2107 to allow the use of a credit card to post bond on certain enumerated offenses. Such cards, issued by banks, allow the violator to deposit a draft with the arresting officer, which draft is returned upon the violator's appearance for further proceedings before the court, or, alternatively, is forfeited upon nonappearance. The withholding of a predetermined amount by the issuer of the card from the amount posted as bond is not a violation of the Truth-in-Lending Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1601 et seq., in that there is no credit trans-

action which is subject thereto. Neither is there a violation of anti-trust laws by virtue of two or more banks entering into agreements to purchase such drafts at such a discount, provided such agreements are drafted by a state agency and then presented to such banks for their signature. Advisory Opinion No. 82-15

Written to Philip K. Kline, President, Shafer, Kline & Warren, P.A., Civil Engineers and Land Surveyors, 11100 West 91st Street, Overland Park, Kansas 66204.

This opinion is in response to your letter of July 2, 1982, in which you request an opinion from the Kansas Public Disclosure Commission concerning the Campaign Finance Act (K.S.A. 25-4143 et seq.).

We understand you request this opinion as a candidate for state office. You advise us that you are a founder, the President and chief officer of Shafer, Kline & Warren, P.A., Civil Engineers and Land Surveyors.

You state in addition to your salary you are furnished a company automobile, titled in the company name, which you use both on company business and as your personal automobile. This compensation has been received since 1951.

You advise us that you anticipate using the automobile in your campaign and ask whether the use of the vehicle constitutes an in-kind contribution from your company which is reportable under the Campaign Finance Act.

K.S.A. 25-4143(d)(1) defines contribution and includes in that definition that a purpose of the giving be to influence the nomination or election of an individual to state office. Given the long-term duration of your use of a company vehicle, we cannot infer that the giving of that compensation any way relates to your seeking office. It is, therefore, our opinion that the use by you of a company automobile which is also yours for personal use does not in this case constitute a reportable in-kind contribution.

Advisory Opinion No. 82-16

Written July 21, 1982 to The Honorable James D. Braden, Representative, 64th District, 606 Grove, Wakefield, Kansas 67487.

This opinion is in response to your letter of July 8, 1982, in which you request an opinion from the Kansas Public Disclosure Commission concerning the Campaign Finance Act (K.S.A. 25-4142 et seq.). (continued)

We understand you request this opinion in your capacity as a candidate for state office. Since you are unopposed in both the primary and general elections, you have filed an affidavit of exemption from filing campaign finance reports pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4173.

You advise us that you have a balance in the amount of \$144.74 in your campaign treasury left over from your successful 1980 election and are considering contributing that amount to another candidate for state

You ask whether the giving of the contribution will reduce the amount of expenditures you may make and still be authorized to file the affidavit of exemption.

K.S.A. 25-4173 states: Every candidate for state office who intends to expend or have expended on such person's behalf an aggregate amount or value of less than \$500.00 and who intends to receive or have received on such person's behalf contributions in an aggregate amount or value of less than \$500.00 in each the primary and the general election shall file, prior to the date that the first report for such year is required to be filed, an affidavit of such intent with the secretary of state. No report required by K.S.A. 25-4148 shall be required to be filed by or for such candidate.

As you correctly note in your letter the issue is the interpretation of the phrase, "intends to expend or have expended on such person's behalf". The language is subject to two interpretations. It could be argued the language was intended to convey the thought that any funds expended at the candidate's direction, regardless of the purpose, were to be included in determining the threshold limits. On the other hand, the language may be interpreted to require the expenditure to be for the benefit of the candidate's campaign. Given the ambiguity in the language and recognizing the remedial nature of this particular section of the Act, it is our opinion that the contribution you contemplate would not be taken into consideration in determining the \$500.00 expenditure threshold so long as the recipient does not use the funds in any manner to benefit your campaign.
