KANSAS LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING COMMISSION

OPEN MEETING NOTICE AND NOTICE TO ALL PERSONS HAVING AN INTEREST IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE KANSAS LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS' STANDARDS AND TRAINING

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training will hold an open meeting on October 26, 1983, at 10:00 a.m., in the conference room of the Law Enforcement Training Center, located at the former site of the U.S. Naval Air Station in Reno County, Kansas.

The scheduled agenda for the Open Meeting includes:

- —Public hearing concerning the adoption on a temporary basis of certain proposed administrative regulations. A summary of the proposed regulations is set forth below. The proposed changes are scheduled to become effective upon approval by the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules and Regulations.
- 1. 106-1-1. Definitions. This regulation is being adopted to define the words and phrases which will be used in the regulation.
- 2. 106-1-2. Grounds for suspension, revocation or denial of certification. This regulation is being adopted to state reasons for suspension, revocation or denial of the certification of a law enforcement officer.

- 3. 106-1-3. Investigation and hearings on charges. This regulation is being adopted to:
- (a) Set forth the means by which the commission shall investigate a verified complaint or upon its own motion.
- (b) Set the time and place of the hearing and establish a chairman of the hearing board.
- 4. 106-1-4. Rules of evidence. This regulation is being adopted to set forth the rules of evidence to be followed and the suspending of the technical rules of evidence if warranted.
- 5. 106-I-5. Records of proceedings. This regulation is being adopted to provide a record of all testimony before the hearing board.
- 6. 106-1-6. Hearing board decision and review. This regulation is being adopted to address the time period in which the hearing board must render its decision and, in addition, provide for a review by the full commission if requested.
- 7. 106-1-7. Voluntary revocation and waiver of hearing. This regulation is being adopted to allow a law enforcement officer to voluntarily be revoked and to waive the hearing process.
- 8. 106-1-8. Reinstatement of certification. This regulation is being adopted to provide a means whereby a law enforcement officer's certification which has been revoked can be reinstated.

A copy of the proposed regulations and fiscal impact statement may be obtained prior to the above-mentioned hearing by contacting Colonel David Hornbaker, Kansas Highway Patrol, 122 SW 7th Street, Topeka, Kansas 66603, (913) 232-9200. Written comments submitted prior to the hearing should be forwarded to Mr. Bernal Cantwell, Chairman, Kansas Law Enforcement Training Commission on Peace Officers Standards and Training, c/o Kansas Sheriff's Association, 226 S. Hampton, Topeka, Kansas 66612.

Interested persons will be given reasonable opportunity at the hearing to present their views and arguments on the adoption of the proposed regulations. Presentations should be in writing whenever possible. Depending on the number of persons wanting to speak, the commission may require that each participant limit oral presentation to no more than five minutes.

NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROPOSED TEMPORARY ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

A public hearing will be held on Wednesday, October 26, 1983, commencing at 10:00 a.m., in the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center's Conference Room, located at the former site of the U.S. Naval Air Station in Reno County, Kansas, to consider the adoption of proposed temporary rules and regulations of the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center.

All interested parties may submit written comments at any time prior to the hearing by addressing them to the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center, P.O. Box 647, Hutchinson, KS 67501. All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity at the hearing to present their views, orally, in regard to the adoption of the proposed regulations. In order to give all parties an opportunity to present their views, it may be necessary to request each participant to limit oral presentation to not more than five (5) minutes.

Following the hearing on October 26, 1983, all written and oral comments submitted by interested parties will be considered by the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center as the basis for making changes to these proposed regulations.

Copies of the regulations and the fiscal impact statement may be obtained by writing Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center, P.O. Box 647, Hutchinson, KS 67501.

The following is a brief summary of the proposed regulations:

K.A.R. 107-1-1 defines certain terms used in the proposed regulations.

K.A.R. 107-1-2 proposes regulations relating to the minimum training requirements and qualifications needed for the certification of police or law enforcement officers. It also defines the agency's, as well as full and part-time officers' duties, regarding basic law enforcement training.

K.A.R. 107-1-3 and 107-1-4 proposes regulations relating to the minimum requirements needed before certification of training schools will be issued by the associate director.

K.A.R. 107-1-5 proposes minimum standards for the satisfactory completion of law enforcement training courses.

K.A.R. 107-2-1 requires all full-time police or law enforcement officers to complete 40 hours of training in subjects relating directly to law enforcement annually.

FISH AND GAME COMMISSION

NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROPOSED TEMPORARY AND PERMANENT ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

A public hearing will be held on Wednesday, October 26, 1983, commencing at 2:00 p.m., at Commission headquarters in Pratt, to consider the adoption of proposed temporary and permanent rules and regulations of the Fish and Game Commission.

All interested parties may submit written comments at any time prior to the hearing by addressing them to the Director of the Kansas Fish and Game Commission, Rt. 2, Box 54A, Pratt, Kansas 67124. Following the hearing, all written and oral comments submitted by interested parties will be considered by the Commission as the basis for making any changes to these proposed regulations.

Summaries of the regulations follow. Copies of the regulations and the fiscal impact statements may be obtained by writing to the agency in Pratt.

K.A.R. 23-1-10, as amended, alters time for successful and unsuccessful turkey hunters to report results of their hunt; eases shot size restrictions; and clarifies eligibility for permit drawings.

K.A.R. 23-3-18 is a proposed new regulation establishing certain conditions for possession of fish, amphibians, reptiles and shellfish used for commercial purposes.

K.A.R. 23-6-6, as amended, specifies locations where certain body gripping traps shall be used; authorizes furharvesters to hold furs through a written request; restricts locations for use of share type devices; and prohibits possession of furs taken from the described locations of share type devices.

K.A.R. 23-6-8 is a proposed new regulation authorizing up to two unlicensed, nonparticipating observers to accompany a licensed furharvester under certain conditions.

K.A.R 23-7-7 is a proposed new regulation that provides for fur dealers application and licenses; establishes fur dealer authority; provides for possession of furs; specifies record book informational requirements; and establishes conditions for revocation of license or denial of application.

K.A.R. 23-7-1, 23-7-2, 23-7-3, and 23-7-4 will be revoked and basic elements of all have been combined into proposed new regulation K.A.R. 23-7-7.

K.A.R. 23-1-12 is a proposed temporary regulation that establishes the spring 1984 turkey season.

ATTORNEY GENERAL

OPINION NO. 83-144

Taxation—Retailers' Sales Tax—Exemptions; Property Consumed in Process of Production. Senator Frank D. Gaines, Sixteenth District, Augusta, September 21, 1983.

The sale of acid which is used to treat a salt water disposal well, which well is utilized in the process of oil production, is exempt from the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act under the provisions of K.S.A. 1982 Supp. 79-3602(m) and 79-3606(n). Cited herein: K.S.A. 1982 Supp. 79-3602(m), 79-3606(n). RJB

OPINION NO. 83-145

Automobiles and Other Vehicles—Registration of Vehicles—Definitions. The Honorable Keith Farrar, State Representative, One Hundred Twenty-Fourth District, Hugoton, September 22, 1983.

The definition of "truck tractor" in K.S.A. 8-126(e) cannot be construed so as to exclude a vehicle which is designed and used primarily for drawing other vehicles, even though it also is capable of carrying a load in addition to part of the weight of a drawn vehicle. Accordingly, the power unit in a combination of vehicles commonly known as a "dromedary rig" must be regarded as a truck tractor, since it is designed and used primarily for drawing other vehicles. Cited herein: K.S.A. 8-126. BJS

OPINION NO. 83-146

Cities and Municipalities—Parks, Public Squares, Market Squares—Land for Park Purposes; Sales or Exchanges. Keith Wilson, Liberal City Attorney, Liberal, September 15, 1983.

A city does not "own" park property acquired by dedication upon filing of a plat, and may not sell such property. Cited herein: K.S.A. 12-101, 12-406, 12-504, 12-1301, Kan. Const., Art. 12, § 5. TRH

OPINION NO. 83-147

Automobiles and Other Vehicles—Act Regulating Traffic; Equipment of Vehicles—Motor Vehicle Inspection. Colonel David Hornbaker, Superintendent, Kansas Highway Patrol, Topeka, September 23, 1983.

K.S.A. 8-1701, which makes the operation of a motor vehicle lacking the proper equipment a misdemeanor, refers only to that equipment which is required by K.S.A. 8-1703 to 8-1749a.

K.S.A. 8-1753 does not authorize the Kansas Highway Patrol to implement rules and regulations establishing the type of equipment to be inspected by the motor vehicle inspection stations. The Kansas Highway Patrol may implement regulations governing only the method of inspection. Cited herein: K.S.A. 8-1701, 8-1703, 8-1749a, 8-1750, 8-1752, 8-1753. MWB
