A public hearing will be conducted at 10 a.m. Friday, October 16, in the Kansas Bureau of Investigation's auditorium, 1620 S.W. Tyler, Topeka, to consider the adoption of proposed temporary and permanent rules and regulations of the Kansas Board

of Polygraphists.

All interested parties may submit written comments prior to the hearing to the executive director of the Kansas Board of Polygraphists, Office of the Attorney General, 2nd Floor, Kansas Judicial Center, Topeka 66612. All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity at the hearing to orally express their views in regard to the adoption of the proposed regulations. In order to give all parties an opportunity to present their views, it may be necessary to request each participant to limit oral presentation to five minutes.

Following the hearing, all written and oral comments submitted by interested parties will be considered by the board as the basis for making changes to the proposed regulations. A copy of the regulations and the fiscal impact statement may be obtained by writing to the executive director of the board at the address above.

The following is a brief summary of the proposed regulations:

K.A.R. 112-1-1 requires a polygraphist or intern license to conduct polygraph examinations. A polygraph examination is defined.

K.A.R. 112-2-1 describes standards of practice for

administering polygraph examinations.

K.A.R. 112-3-1 through K.A.R. 112-3-4 describe the application process for obtaining a license as a polygraphist or intern.

K.A.R. 112-4-1 provides information on board ap-

proved educational institutions.

K.A.R. 112-5-1 through K.A.R. 112-5-4 describe the internship process, including intern and supervisor responsibilities.

K.A.R. 112-6-1 through K.A.R. 112-6-5 describe the written and practical examination process, including

scheduling and re-examination.

K.A.R. 112-7-1 sets polygraphist, intern and reciprocal license application fees, renewal license application fees, late renewal fees, examination and re-examination fees.

K.A.R. 112-7-2 allows prorating of fees.

K.A.R. 112-7-3 sets the deadline for payment of fees.

K.A.R. 112-7-4 sets December 31 as the expiration date for polygraphist and intern licenses.

K.A.R. 118-8-1 provides information on filing complaints.

There is no fiscal impact to governmental agencies or businesses resulting from the adoption of these proposed regulations other than the cost of licensing to the applicants.

Opinion No. 87-135

Taxation—Listing Property for Taxation—Oil and Gas Property as Personality: Property Held by Federal Land Bank Exempt from Taxation.

Collection and Cancellation of Taxes-Transfer of Personal Property Before Tax Paid; Collection. William B. Elliott, Graham County Attorney, Hill City, September 11, 1987.

If a person who is not insolvent transfers to a federal land bank (by voluntary conveyance or foreclosure) oil and gas producing interests after assessment but before the payment of personal property taxes, a lien attaches against the property for the unpaid taxes in accordance with K.S.A. 1986 Supp. 79-2020. (We note the question presented does not involve assessing personal property taxes against the federal land bank [see Attorney General Opinion No. 86-16]. The question presented involves determining the priority of claims against the personal property transferred.)

Under this statute the federal land bank takes subject to the lien, is liable for the tax, and has a civil cause of action against the transferor for the amount paid. However, insolvency of the debtor and subsequent transfer of property by the debtor for the benefit of creditors will make the priority issue a question of federal law triggering 31 U.S.C. § 3713 (formerly 31 U.S.C. § 191), priority of government claims.

The procedure for obtaining an exemption from the payment of ad valorem property taxes is found in K.S.A. 1986 Supp. 79-213. While a federal land bank is exempt from the assessment of ad valorem taxes, as a property owner requesting an exemption it is not exempt from the procedure of filing for an exemption. Intoxicating Liquors and Beverages-Cereal Malt Beverages-Definition of "Premises." Paul E. McPhillips, Mayor, Garden Plain, September 15, 1987.

K.S.A. 41-2701 et seq., as amended by L. 1987, ch. 182 and L. 1987, ch. 183, regulates the sale and consumption of cereal malt beverages. However, neither Article 27, nor any subsequent amending legislation, contains a definition for "premises." Therefore, since the consumption of cereal malt beverages is not an area of concern exclusively reserved by the state, a local licensing authority may prescribe, within reason, its own definition of what constitutes "premises." Laws, Journals and Public Information—Records Open to Public—Lists of Names and Addresses Derived from Public Records; Prohibited Uses.

Crimes and Punishments—Kansas Criminal Code; Prohibited Conduct; Crimes Affecting Public Trusts—Unlawful Use of Names Derived from Public Records. Philip S. Harness, Johnson County Counselor, Olathe, September 15, 1987.

A custodian of public records who reasonably believes that a requestor will use the information for prohibited purposes must deny access to the records. Disclosure of the information in such a case will subject the custodian to possible criminal charges. The Kansas Open Records Act does not require a public agency which maintains records on computer facilities to write a computer program to produce requested information in a certain form if the information is available in existing records. State Departments; Public Officers and Employees—Private Investigative or Security Operations—Arson Investigation, by Licensed Engineers; Testimony by Out-of-State Arson Investigators. Ed C. Redmon, State Fire Marshal, Topeka; Representative Phil Kline, 19th District, Overland Park, September 18, 1987.

1. Engineers and private arson investigators consulting in cases requiring the use of their technical knowledge are exempt from K.S.A. 75-7b01(a).

2. Persons may testify as expert witnesses in Kansas in matters in which they are qualified, even though they may not be licensed within that profession by the state of Kansas. Cited herein: K.S.A. 60-456b; 75-7b01a; 75-7b02(a). BLB

Procedure, Civil—Rules of Evidence; Privileges— Physician-Patient Privilege. Gene Marks, Barton County Sheriff, Great Bend, September 19, 1987.

When an inmate is given a medical examination upon arrival at a detention facility pursuant to intake procedures, the physician-patient privilege may be invoked to prevent disclosure of confidential communications in a civil action or misdemeanor criminal case, subject to statutory exceptions. Public policy supports the confidentiality of communications between the patient and physician beyond the witness stand.

Such policy must give way, however, when the public's right to know about the patient's dangerous condition outweighs the individual's privacy interests. In that case, a physician would be justified in notifying sheriff's department personnel so that steps may be taken to protect the health interest of other inmates. Crimes and Punishments—Crimes Against the Public Morals—Legality of Electronic Crane Amusement Game. Senator Paul Feleciano, Jr., 28th District, Wichita, September 18, 1987.

Electronic crane amusement games involve the use of skill by the player to win a prize, and therefore are not gambling devices as defined by Kansas law. Cited herein: K.S.A. 21-4302, as amended by L. 1987 ch. 112, § 23 and by L. 1987 ch. 292, § 23. BLB

Taxation—Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax—Exempt Sales.

Taxation—Income Tax—Taxable Income. Senator Ben E. Vidricksen, 24th District, Salina, September 22, 1987.

A non-profit hospital operating a telephone answering service exclusively for hospital purposes is exempt from payment of sales tax on the telephone services it purchases for such operation (K.S.A. 1986 Supp. 79-3606(b), as amended). A telephone answering service is not itself taxable under the Kansas retailers' sales tax act, but the rental of beepers or other such equipment by the hospital to physicians is taxable (K.S.A. 1986 Supp. 79-3603(h), as amended).

A non-profit hospital which meets the requirements of 26 U.S.C. § 501 and 26 C.F.R. § 1.501 is exempt from federal income taxation pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 501(a), and thus from state income taxation pursuant to K.S.A. 79-32,113, except to the extent it receives 'unrelated business income." The receipt of a service free of charge from an employer as partial compensation for services rendered would fall within the scope of the broadly interpreted term "gross income," and therefore would be taxable income to the employee unless specifically exempted. Each interest rate specified shall be a multiple of 1/8 or 1/20 of 1 percent. Authority, Purpose and Security for the Bonds

The Series "A" bridge bonds are being issued pursuant to and in full compliance with the constitution and laws of the state of Kansas, including the Kansas general law and K.S.A. 68-1103(b), as amended, and resolutions 1984-42 and 1984-43, for the purpose of repairing and reconstructing of bridges in Leavenworth County.

The Series "B" equipment bonds are being issued pursuant to and in full compliance with the constitution and laws of the state of Kansas, including the Kansas general bond law, K.S.A. 19-101a(a) and 19-101(b), and resolutions 1985-20 and 1985-21, for the purpose of purchasing, repairing or replacing equipment, apparatus or machinery necessary for street, road and bridge construction, repair or maintenance within the county.

Legal Opinion and Tax Exemption

In the opinion of Burke, Williams, Sorensen & Gaar, Overland Park, Kansas, bond counsel, assuming continued compliance by the county with the terms of the bond resolution, under existing law, the interest on the bonds (a) is excludable from gross income for federal income tax purposes and (b) is not an item of preference for purposes of the federal alternative minimum tax imposed on individuals and corporations; however, it should be noted that with respect to corporations (as defined for federal income tax purposes), such interest is taken into account in determining adjusted net book income (adjusted current earnings for taxable years ending after Decembeer 31, 1989) for the purpose of computing the alternative minimum tax imposed on such corporations. No opinion is expressed regarding other federal tax consequences arising with respect to the bonds.

The Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, imposes certain requirements which must be met subsequent to the issuance of the bonds in order for

the interest thereon to be and remain excluded from gross income for federal income tax purposes. Noncompliance with such requirements could cause the interest on the bonds to be so included in federal gross income retroactive to the date of issue of the bonds. These requirements include, but are not limited to, limitations on the use of bond proceeds and restrictions on the yield which may be earned on the investment of bond proceeds and other amounts. In the resolution authorizing the issuance of the bonds, the county will covenant to comply with the provisions of the code relating to the exclusion of the interest on the bonds from gross income for federal income tax purposes.

The county *has* designated the bonds as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" within the meaning of Section 265(b)(3) of the code.

Prospective purchasers of the bonds should be aware that (1) Section 265 of the code denies a deduction for interest on indebtedness incurred or continued to purchase or carry the bonds or, in the case of a financial institution (within the meaning of Section 265(b)(5) of the code), that portion of an owner's interest expense allocable to interest on the bonds; (2) with respect to insurance companies subject to the tax imposed by Section 831 of the code, for taxable years beginning after December 31, 1986, Section 832(b)(5)(i) reduces the deduction for loss reserved by 15 percent of the sum of certain items, including interest on the bonds; (3) for taxable years beginning after December 31, 1986 and before January 1, 1992, interest on the bonds earned by some corporations could be subject to the environmental tax imposed by Section 59A of the code; (4) for taxable years beginning after December 31, 1986, interest on the bonds earned by certain foreign corporations doing business in the United States should be subject to a branch profits tax imposed by Section 884 of the code; (5) passive investment income, including interest on the bonds, may be subject to federal income taxation under Section 1375 of the code for Subchapter S corporations that have Subchapter C earnings and profits at the close of the taxable year if greater than 25 percent of the gross receipts of such Subchapter S corporation is passive investment income; and (6) Section 86 of the code requires recipients of certain Social Security and certain railroad retirement benefits to take into account in determining gross income, receipts or accruals of interest on the bonds. These categories of bondowners should consult their own tax advisers to the applicability of these consequences.

A form of bond counsel's opinion is contained in the official statement of the county with respect to the bonds.

Delivery and Payment

The county will pay for printing the bonds, the legal services and bond opinion thereon, and will deliver the same properly prepared, executed, and registered without cost to the successful bidder within six days after the date of sale at such bank or trust company as may be suggested by the successful bidder and is acceptable to the county without cost to the successful

bidder. Said bidder will also be furnished with a certified transcript of the proceedings evidencing the authorization and issuance of the bonds and the usual closing proofs, which will include a certificate that there is no litigation pending or threatened at the time of the delivery of the bonds affecting their validity. Payment for the bonds must be made in federal reserve funds, immediately subject to use by the county.

Bond counsel's opinion will be printed on the reverse side of each bond, and a manually signed original will be furnished without expense to the successful bidder concurrently with delivery of the bonds. All fees and expenses of bond counsel will be paid by the city. A specimen form of bond counsel's opinion is contained in the city's official statement regarding these bonds.

In the opinion of bond counsel, assuming continued compliance by the city with the terms of the bond ordinance, under existing law, the interest on the bonds is: (i) excludable from gross income for federal income tax purposes; and (ii) is not an item of tax preference for purposes of the federal alternative minimum tax imposed on individuals and corporations. However, it should be noted that with respect to corporations (as defined for federal income tax purposes), such interest is taken into account in determining adjusted net book income (adjusted current earnings for taxable years ending after December 31, 1989) for the purpose of computing the alternative

minimum tax imposed on such corporations. The exclusion mentioned in the preceding clause (i) is subject to compliance by the city with all requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, which must be satisfied subsequent to issuance of the bonds in order for the interest on the bonds to qualify for such exclusion. Failure to comply with certain of such requirements could cause the interest on the bonds to be so included in gross income retroactive to the date of issuance thereof. The city will covenant to comply with all such requirements. Bond counsel expresses no opinion regarding other federal tax consequences arising with respect to the bonds.

Prospective bidders for purchase of the bonds should be aware that: (i) Section 265 of the code denies a deduction for interest on indebtedness incurred or continued to purchase or carry the bonds, except with respect to certain financial institutions within the meaning of Section 265(b)(5) of the code; (ii) with respect to insurance companies subject to the tax imposed by Section 831 of the code, for taxable vears beginning after December 31, 1986. Section 832(b)(5)(B)(i) of the code reduces the deduction for loss reserves by 15 percent of the sum of certain items. including interest on the bonds; (iii) for taxable years beginning after December 31, 1986 and prior to January 1, 1992, interest earned on the bonds by some corporations could be subject to the environmental tax imposed by Section 59A of the code; (iv) for taxable years beginning after December 31, 1986, interest earned on the bonds by certain foreign corporations doing business in the United States could be subject to a branch profits tax imposed by Section 884 of the code; (v) passive investment income, including interest on the bonds, may be subject to federal income taxation under Section 1375 of the code for Subchapter S corporations that have Subchapter C earnings and profits at the close of the taxable year if more than 25 percent of the gross receipts of such Subchapter S corporation is passive investment income; and (vi) Section 86 of the code requires recipients of certain Social Security and railroad retirement benefits to take into account in determining gross income, receipts or accruals of interest on the bonds. The foregoing categories of prospective bondowners should consult their own tax advisers as to the applicability of any of these consequences.

The bonds are exempt from intangible personal property taxes levied by Kansas counties, cities and townships.

Qualified Tax-Exempt Obligations

The city will covenant to take such actions as are necessary to designate the bonds as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" within the meaning of Section 265(b)(3) of the code; and, in the case of certain financial institutions within the meaning of Section 265(b)(5) of the code, a deduction is allowed for 80 percent of that portion of such financial institution's interest expense allocable to interest on the bonds.


