Executive Order No. 95-172 Re-establishing the Koch Crime Commission

WHEREAS, crime creates tragic situations for victims, their families and our children; and

WHEREAS, the quality of life for all citizens of Kansas is adversely affected by a resulting loss of security and safety; and

WHEREAS, the causes of criminal conduct are complex

and solutions must be comprehensive; and

WHEREAS, the welfare of the citizens of the State of Kansas is best served by focused efforts in addressing ways in which criminal conduct can be reduced and prevented.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Kansas, I hereby reestablish the Koch Crime Commission.

- 1. The chairperson of the Commission shall be William I. Koch, who will be a standing member of the Commission. The Governor also shall be a standing member.
- 2. The Governor shall appoint other members of the Commission who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor and who shall meet upon the call of the chairperson as necessary to carry out its duties under

this executive order. Membership on the Commission by the non-standing members shall be by official commission of appointment of the Governor, certified by and filed with the Secretary of State.

3. Members of the Commission shall receive no compensation, subsistence allowance, mileage or expenses from the State

from the State.

4. The Commission shall act independently of the Governor's office and shall set its own agenda and meeting schedule.

5. The Commission shall provide recommendations for future actions that will aid in the reduction and prevention of criminal conduct and protection of the

citizens of the State of Kansas.

6. Executive Order No. 94-163 is hereby rescinded. The provisions of this executive order shall expire on June 30, 1997, unless rescinded earlier by executive order.

This document shall be filed with the Secretary of State as Executive Order No. 95-172, and shall become effective immediately.

Kansas Commission on Governmental Standards and Conduct

Advisory Opinion No. 95-7

Written March 14, 1995, to Kenneth M. Wilke, Chief Counsel, Kansas Department of Agriculture, Topeka.

This opinion is in response to your letter of March 13, 1995, in which you request an opinion from the Kansas Commission on Governmental Standards and Conduct concerning the state conflict of interest laws (K.S.A. 46-215 et seq.).

Factual Statement

We understand you request this opinion in your capacity as chief counsel for the Kansas Department of Agriculture. You advise us that the secretary of the Kansas Department of Agriculture (hereinafter agency) needs to travel to a seminar and panel discussion concerning agricultural issues.

The seminar will be held in western Kansas and, due to time constraints and scheduling, air travel is the preferred method of travel. The agency is contemplating making arrangements to use the Governor's plane or chartering an aircraft to attend the seminar.

Included in the passenger list would be one or more individuals from an organization which is not licensed, regulated or inspected by the agency. The organization has voluntarily offered to pay its fair share of the cost for chartering an airplane.

Question

Is it permissible for representatives of a private entity to reimburse the agency for their fair share of the costs of the airplane charter?

Opinion

K.S.A. 46-237 relates to your question. K.S.A. 46-237(a) provides:

No state officer or employee or candidate for state office shall accept, or agree to accept any economic opportunity, gift, loan, gratuity, special discount, favor, hospitality, or service having an aggregate value of \$40 or more in any calendar year from any one person known to have a special interest, under circumstances where such person knows or should know that a major purpose of the donor is to influence such person in the performance of their official duties or prospective official duties.

The issue in this situation is whether this payment is a "gift" under the conflict of interest laws. This situation is analogous to a private entity paying for the travel expenses of a state officer or employee. This commission has consistently held that K.S.A. 46-237(a) does not apply to situations where the agency authorizes and is willing to pay for the travel expenses, because nothing inures to the benefit of the state officer.

Thus, since the Board of Agriculture is willing to pay for the costs of chartering the airplane, this section does not prohibit the situation you have described.

In closing, this commission has no jurisdiction over the use by non-state employees of state property or commercial property contracted for by a state agency.

The recommendations of the panels will be acted upon by the commission during its quarterly business meeting in June, when the actual grant amounts will be determined and announced.

Meetings of the Kansas Arts Commission, a state agency, and its advisory panels are open to public observation. Applicants are encouraged to attend the panel meetings and hear the critiques of their applications and programs. Applicants do not make presentations to the panels, but may answer questions posed at the request of the panelists.

Funding for commission programs is provided through grants from the National Endowment for the Arts, a federal agency, and appropriations by the Kansas Logiclature
