## Kansas Council on Developmental Disabilities

### Notice of Available Funding

The Kansas Council on Developmental Disabilities (KCDD) announces the availability, pending Congressional action, of developmental disabilities funding totaling \$110,000 to be distributed by state plan activities. Approximate funding amounts available for each competition are listed in the parentheses following the program.

- I. For state plan goal activities which focus on advocacy in the following area: Leadership, Advocacy and Education (\$50,000). Only one project will be funded.
- II. For state plan goal activities which focus on employment in the following area: Small Business Innovations (\$20,000 maximum for each proposal). Up to three projects will be funded.

### Application Process

### General Requirements

**Eligible Applicants:** State, public, private profit or non-profit organizations, institutions, agencies or individuals.

**Project Duration:** The projected duration for projects is November 1, 1996 to September 30, 1997.

**Council Share of the Project Cost:** The maximum council contribution cannot exceed 75 percent of the annual project budget.

**Matching Requirement:** Successful applicants must contribute at least 25 percent or one-fourth of the actual annual project budget.

### Evaluation and Selection

Completed applications will be given a project number, analyzed by a review committee and evaluated based on content: narrative, methodology, budget, qualifications of the applicant and adherence to specific criteria included in the application. Additionally, applicants should be aware that the council and review committee will note whether the application addresses the needs of diverse populations and/or rural Kansans with developmental disabilities.

Grant project awards will depend upon the availability of federal developmental disability funding. Final decisions for grant project awards will be made by the KCDD.

### Deadline

Completed applications will be accepted at the KCDD office until 5 p.m. September 20. No handwritten, faxed or single-spaced documents will be accepted.

Interested persons are urged to respond promptly to this solicitation. Completed applications received after the deadline will not be considered nor returned to you.

Applicants will be notified of the KCDD decision by October 25. The project award period will be November 1, 1996 to September 30, 1997, unless otherwise noted.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment is soliciting comments regarding a proposed air quality construction permit. Mesa Operating Company has applied for an air quality construction permit in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-300 to install and operate an amine stripping unit, reboiler and flare. Emissions of SO<sub>x</sub>, H<sub>2</sub>S, VOC, NO<sub>x</sub> and CO were evaluated during the permit review process.

Mesa Operating Company, P.O. Box 2009, Amarillo, TX 79189, owns and operates the stationary source located at Section 10, Township 30S, Range 37W, Grant County, Kansas, at which the amine stripper system is to be constructed.

In the absence of statutory authorization, county treasurers may not charge an additional \$2 fee per motor vehicle registration when registrants use a "satellite" registration facility. Because the registration fee statutes are uniform and a resolution allowing additional fees would be in conflict therewith, counties may not alter this conclusion by home rule. ## Opinion No. 96-67

No constitutional or statutory authority exists for the election of fire district trustees at a general election. Absent such authority, no valid election of fire district trustees may be called and held at the general election conducted in either April or November. ## Article 1.—GENERAL OPERATION

**111-1-5. Restrictions on who may participate.** (a) Persons directly involved in the production of the televised draw show, the installation and maintenance of computers or computer equipment for on-line games, the installation and maintenance of telecommunications equipment connecting on-line terminals to the central computer system, and any person, or any officers, agents or employees of a business providing supplies, services and equipment used directly in the operation of a lottery game or any other employee of such a business working the majority of his or her time at the Kansas lottery or any regional lottery office, are precluded from purchasing lottery tickets and from winning prizes. Persons only tangentially connected to the Kansas lottery are not included within this prohibition.

(b) In the event of a dispute concerning this requirement, the executive director has the authority to determine the facts underlying the dispute and make a decision as to the participation of such a person in purchasing lottery tickets and winning prizes. ## Article 7.—CASH LOTTO GAME RULES

**111-7-66. Game description; drawing.** (a) Pick 3 is a daily game in which drawings shall be conducted every day but Sunday in accordance with lottery procedures.

(b) To play Pick 3 a player shall select a set of three single digit numbers from three sets of single digit numbers beginning with zero and progressing by increments of one through the number nine by (1) communicating the numbers to the retailer; (2) marking up to four boards on each play slip and submitting the play slip to the retailer; or (3) requesting a quick pick from the retailer.

(c) The cost of a single ticket shall be either \$.50 per play times the number of plays, or \$1.00 per play times the number of plays, depending on the type of wager to be made.

(d) A validated ticket shall be the only proof of a game play or plays, and the submission of a winning ticket to and receipt of the ticket by the lottery or its authorized retailer shall be the sole method of claiming a prize or prizes. A play slip has no pecuniary or prize value and shall not constitute evidence of ticket purchase, of numbers selected or prizes to be paid.

(e) A ticket may be cancelled as provided in K.A.R. 111-6-20.

(f) Ticket sales will end at approximately 6:45 p.m. central time on each drawing day and resume at approximately 7:00 p.m. Effective August 18, 1996, sales

will end at approximately 8:59 p.m. central time on each drawing day and resume at approximately 9:05 p.m. for the next drawing.

(g) Drawings will be conducted daily except Sundays after ticket sales end, under conditions and procedures promulgated by the executive director of the lottery. Winning number combinations shall be generated daily except Sundays through the use of a computer-driven random number generator located at lottery headquarters. The generator shall be statistically analyzed, tested, and certified by an independent qualified statistician for integrity. Periodic checks shall be made to ensure the security and integrity of the system at least quarterly.

(h) It shall be the sole responsibility of the player to verify the accuracy of the game plays and other data printed on the ticket. The placing of plays is done at the player's own risk through the on-line retailer who is acting on behalf of the player in entering the plays. **111-7-126. Claiming prizes; procedure and time period.** (a) Following the drawing for which a Kansas Cash ticket was purchased, and prior to the payment of that prize, each ticket shall be validated by any on-line retailer or any Kansas lottery office pursuant to K.A.R. 111-6-7 and this article.

(b) The procedure for payment of a prize on any single game ticket of \$599 or less, except for a jackpot prize, is as follows:

(1) The holder of a ticket purchased in Kansas may present the ticket to any on-line retailer. Upon validation of the ticket, the retailer shall immediately make payment of the prize to the holder. If the retailer cannot validate the claim, the claimant shall fill out a claim form provided by the retailer and personally present or mail the completed form, together with the ticket, to any office of the Kansas lottery. If the claim is validated at lottery headquarters, then payment shall be made either directly to the claimant if personally present or by mail.

(2) The claimant may bring the signed ticket to any regional office of the Kansas lottery during the hours that the office is open to the public for business. Upon validation of the claim, and completion of a claim form, payment shall be processed for the claimant.

(3) The claimant may mail the ticket with a completed claim form in any envelope, to any office of the Kansas lottery. Claim forms may be obtained from any lottery retailer or any office of the Kansas lottery. Upon validation of the claim, payment shall be processed for the claimant.

If the evidence of alteration, mutilation, tear, or other ambiguity appears on the ticket, the retailer shall not make the direct payment of a prize. The claimant shall submit a claim form with the ticket to the lottery.

(c) The procedure for the payment of a Kansas Cash prize on any single game ticket which totals \$600 or more, except for a jackpot prize, shall be as follows:

(1) The claimant may bring the signed ticket to any office of the Kansas lottery during the hours that the office is open to the public for business. Upon validation of the claim and completion of a claim form, payment shall be processed for the claimant.

(2) The claimant may mail the signed ticket with a completed claim form to any office of the Kansas lottery. Claim forms may be obtained from any lottery retailer or any office of the Kansas lottery. Upon validation of the claim, payment shall be processed for the claimant.

(d) The procedure for the payment of a jackpot prize or for prizes won on the same ticket as a jackpot prize are as follows:

The claimant shall personally submit the signed ticket and a completed claim form to Kansas lottery headquarters or to a regional Kansas lottery office in Great Bend and Wichita. Jackpot prizes and prizes won on the same ticket as jackpot prizes shall not be claimed by mail.

(e) All prizes shall be claimed within 365 days of the drawing in which the prize was won. Any prize or prizes not claimed within the time specified shall be forfeited. If a prize is claimed by mail, the ticket and claim form must actually be received by the lottery within the claim period.
