Notice of Commencement of Negotiations for Architectural Services

The Division of Facilities Management had been advised that the delivery of that issue of the Kansas Register was delayed to certain subscribers. As a result, this item is being re-published with a revised date to respond.)

Notice is hereby given of the commencement of negotiations for architectural services for the Kansas Wetlands Education Center, Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks, in Cheyenne Bottoms, Barton County. The 12,000 sq. ft. building is to consist of offices, classrooms, work rooms, auditorium, a 1,500 sq. ft. exhibit hall, observation space, gift shop and storage areas. Site work and utilities will include a parking lot, sewer lagoon system, pond, highway access study, and possible reverse osmosis water system. The firm will be responsible for the design of exhibits and displays for the exhibit hall, and the exhibit designer will be approved early on by the agency. Design coordination between several state and local agencies,

and conducting public meetings regarding the project, will be part of the services. The total project cost is \$4,000,000.
