**Notice of Hearing on Proposed  
Administrative Regulations**

A public hearing will be conducted at 1 p.m. Monday, October 17, in Hearing Room 2 in the lower lobby of the US Bank Building, 800 S.W. Jackson, Topeka, to consider the adoption of a proposed rule and regulation of the Division of Workers Compensation.

This 60-day notice of the public hearing shall constitute a public comment period for the purpose of receiving written public comments on the proposed rule and regulation. All interested parties may submit written comments prior to the hearing to the director of the Division of Workers Compensation, 800 S.W. Jackson, Suite 600, Topeka, 66612-1227, or by e-mail to [anne.haught@dol.ks.gov](mailto:anne.haught@dol.ks.gov). All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to present their views orally on the adoption of the proposed regulation during the hearing. In order to give all parties an opportunity to present their views, it may be necessary to request that each participant limit oral presentation to 10 minutes.

Any individual with a disability may request accommodation in order to participate in the public hearing and may request the proposed regulation and economic impact statement in an accessible format. Requests for accommodation should be made at least five working days

in advance of the hearing by contacting Anne Haught at (785) 296-4000. Parking for individuals with disabilities is located on the second level of the US Bank Building's enclosed parking, and the west entrance of the US Bank Building is accessible to individuals with disabilities.

This regulation is proposed for adoption on a permanent basis. A summary of the proposed regulation and its economic impact follows:

**K.A.R. 51-2-5** is an updated regulation authorized by K.S.A. 44-551. It increases the amount of fees that a special administrative law judge may assess. A special administrative law judge may assess \$50, increased from \$30, for each settlement hearing that is heard as part of a regular settlement docket, and may assess \$50, increased from \$35, for a settlement hearing that is heard at an individual setting. A fee of \$100 may be assessed, increased from \$50, for each preliminary hearing, for each full hearing and for each prehearing settlement conference held. A special administrative law judge may charge \$85 per hour, increased from \$60, for preparing and rendering a final award not to exceed \$500, increased from \$240.

A public hearing will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Thursday, October 27, in the third floor conference room, Kansas Insurance Department, 420 S.W. 9th, Topeka, to consider the adoption of proposed changes in existing rules and regulations.

This 60-day notice of the public hearing shall constitute a public comment period for the purpose of receiving written public comments on the proposed rules and regulations. All interested parties may submit written comments prior to the hearing to Deletria Nash, Kansas Insurance Department, 420 S.W. 9th, Topeka, 66612-1678, via facsimile at (785) 291-3673, or via e-mail at dnash@ksinsurance.org. All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to present their views orally on the adoption of the proposed regulations during the hearing.

A summary of the regulations and their economic impact follows:

**K.A.R. 40-2-14a. Life insurance and annuities; recommendation standards.** This proposed regulation provides the criteria for insurers and agents recommending the purchase or surrender of any variable product to consumers. It also provides for the type of information insurers and agents must obtain prior to recommending these products.

The Kansas Insurance Department is proposing to adopt by reference its opinion and memorandum regarding annuity transactions dated June 8, 2005, which is based primarily on the current National Association of Insurance Commissioners' Senior Protection in Annuity Transactions Model Regulation dated October 2003. The

previous regulation, in its entirety, is being replaced by the Kansas Insurance Department's opinion and memorandum.

The economic impact on the companies and the Kansas Insurance Department is minimal because many companies currently have established criteria for themselves and their agents in this regard. There is little or no economic impact on other governmental agencies, while the economic impact on consumers is positive in that consumers who purchase these products will have products that are suitable for their needs.

**K.A.R. 40-2-14b.** This regulation provides the requirement for a compliance program as it pertains to the sale of variable products to consumers. It also puts insurers on notice that the failure to comply with this regulation constitutes a violation of Kansas law and sets out the requirement for companies to maintain records of relevant information pertaining to each transaction.

The economic impact this proposed revocation will have on the companies is positive because companies will have standards to follow in Kansas that are substantially similar to those required by other other states. There is minimal impact on the Kansas Insurance Department, other governmental agencies and consumers.

Executive Order 04-05

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas must continue to be fiscally responsible as we enter the new fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the moratorium placed on employee bonuses for Executive Branch agencies in Fiscal Years 2003 through 2005 resulted in fiscal savings; and

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas has an Award and Recognition Program that authorizes state agencies to recognize and reward employees based on designated program criteria;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Kansas, I am continuing the moratorium on employee bonuses for Fiscal Year 2006 but I am raising the dollar amount limit over Fiscal Year 2005 levels to provide for expanded flexibility when awards are given through the State of Kansas Award and Recognition Program.

This moratorium applies to any bonus issued by contracted agreements, Memorandums of Agreement, Executive Directives, awards authorized by the Award and Recognition Program and Program Guidelines in excess of \$1,000 per employee per fiscal year, and unclassified bonuses in excess of \$1,000 per employee per fiscal year. No new contracted agreements and Memorandums of Agreement should include bonus provisions.

This moratorium does not apply to the longevity bonus, any cash award based on agency savings authorized by the Employee Suggestion Program, and Memorandums of Agreement involving the Regent institutions' university police officers.

Any exceptions to this moratorium must be approved by the Governor's office.

This document shall be filed with the Secretary of State as Executive Order 05-04, and shall be effective June 5, 2005.

Executive Order 05-05

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas is dedicated to the health, safety, and security of all its citizens; and is committed to ensuring that all Kansans have access to appropriate, safe, decent, accessible, and affordable housing of their choice; and

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas recognizes the adverse affect that homelessness and near homelessness has on individuals and families; and that homelessness creates barriers to safety, health, education and full productive participation in one's community; and

WHEREAS, consistent with my administration's initiative for state government to work smarter and more ef-

ficiently while serving Kansans, it is imperative that a comprehensive and coordinated effort be developed so that strategies to alleviate and end homelessness in our State are implemented.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Kansas, I hereby, create the Kansas Interagency Council on Homelessness ("Council") with the following purposes and charges:

1. The heads of the following state agencies and instrumentalities, or their designees, are directed to participate in the Council: Kansas Department on Aging; Kansas Department of Commerce; Kansas Department of Corrections; Kansas Department of Education; Kansas Department of Health and Environment; Kansas Department of Labor; Kansas Department of Social & Rehabilitation Services; Kansas Development Finance Authority, including the Kansas Housing Resources Corporation; Kansas Human Rights Commission; and Kansas Juvenile Justice Authority.

2. The following organizations are also invited to have a representative on the Council: the Veterans' Administration, the independent living centers for persons with disabilities, Kansas Legal Services, Health Care for the Homeless, Kansas Association of Community Action Programs, the Kansas chapter for the National Alliance for the Mentally Ill, Kansas Association for the Medically Underserved, Kansas Statewide Homeless Coalition, Kansas Coalition Against Sexual and Domestic Violence, the Topeka Rescue Mission, Inter-Faith Ministries and Catholic Charities.

3. The Council shall draw upon existing resources to identify and prioritize efforts to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless.

4. The Council is to engage in planning activities to ensure that the resources of each State agency are utilized in the most efficient and effective manner to support the goal of the elimination of homelessness.

5. The Council shall identify and utilize federal, state and other funding opportunities to address and alleviate homelessness within the State.

6. The Council shall work to identify causes and effects of homelessness in Kansas and make recommendations to policy makers and other interested parties.

7. The President of the Kansas Development Finance Authority, or designee, shall convene and preside over the meetings of the Council.

8. The Council will meet as determined by the chair of the Council.

This document shall be filed with the Secretary of State as Executive Order No. 05-05 and shall become effective immediately.

This 60-day notice of the public hearing shall constitute a public comment period for the purpose of receiving written public comments on the proposed rules and regulations. These regulations are proposed for adoption on a permanent basis. A summary of the proposed regulations and their economic impact follows:

**K.A.R. 5-16-1 and K.A.R. 5-16-5** deal with flex accounts for water rights. Flex accounts allow water right owners to have more flexibility in using their water rights over a five-year period while achieving at least a 10 percent savings in water pumped. The regulations are proposed to be modified to make them compatible with K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 82a-736, as amended by L. 2005, ch. 142, sec. 3, effective April 21, 2005. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 82a-736 was amended to change the definition of "base average usage" to use the 11-year period of 1992 through 2002 to compute the average rather than the five-year period of 1996 through 2000, and to allow the conservation of more than 10 percent of the water use permitted. It is not anticipated that these regulatory amendments will have any significant impact on the agency or the regulated public.

A public hearing will be conducted by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment at 7 p.m. Monday, September 26, at the St. Marys State Bank, St. Marys, to receive comments prior to final action on the proposed issuance of an air quality construction permit. KDHE is proposing to issue the permit, in accordance with Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-350, which adopt the standards, procedures and requirements of 40 CFR 52.21 by reference. The permit authorizes a modification to Boiler Unit 3 at Westar Energy's Jeffrey Energy Center (JEC). The project is a NOx reduction project and includes the addition of low NOx burners, separated overfire air (SOFA), and changes to the pulverizer. The JEC is owned and operated by Westar Energy, 818 S. Kansas Ave., Topeka.

The St. Marys area is designated as an attainment area under the Clean Air Act, which means that the air quality meets or exceeds the national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS). Any major source or major modifications to a major source has to undergo a preconstruction review as required by the PSD regulations.

KDHE has determined that an evaluation of emission reduction techniques to identify the best available control technology (BACT) for each pollutant for which the emission rate exceeds the PSD significant level is appropriate. The purpose of BACT is to affect the maximum degree of reduction achievable, taking into account energy, environmental and economic impacts for each pollutant under review. Evaluation of the estimated emissions for the proposed JEC modification indicates that the emission rate of carbon monoxide (CO) exceeds the significance level. No significant impact on the ambient air quality standard for CO was predicted from the emissions. Westar

conducted the required BACT analyses. The department has reviewed Westar's BACT analyses and concurs with its findings that the BACT for CO is good combustion practices due to the technical infeasibility of an oxidation catalyst.
