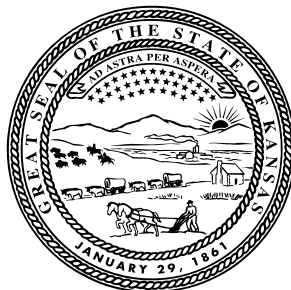

Opinion 2009-08

Written August 19, 2009, to Jason Hawman, WaKeeney.

This opinion is in response to your letter received August 5, 2009, requesting an opinion from the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission concerning the state level conflict of interest laws, K.S.A. 46-215 *et seq.* We note at the outset that the Commission's jurisdiction concerning your question is limited to the application of K.S.A. 46-215 *et seq.*, and whether some other statutory system, common law theory or agency rule or regulation applies to your inquiry is not covered by this opinion.

Factual Statement:

You are writing in your capacity as a Natural Resource Officer II (Game Warden) for the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks (KDWP). Your letter states that the KDWP has denied approval of your outside employment as a high school volleyball coach for USD 208. You have indicated that your job with KDWP would take priority and that a co-coach would be hired to perform your coaching duties when you were fulfilling your primary job duties for KDWP. You would not attempt to alter your KDWP work schedule to meet your coaching obligations. After your request was denied, you were encouraged to seek an opinion from the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission regarding any violations of K.S.A. 46-215 *et seq.* caused by your acceptance of the job as a high school volleyball coach.

Question:

Does the acceptance of the position of volleyball coach for USD 208 violate the state conflict of interests law?

Opinion:

K.S.A. 46-235 provides in pertinent part:

No state officer or employee shall accept compensation for performance of official duties, other than that to which such person is entitled for such performance. No person shall pay or offer to pay any state officer or employee any compensation for performance of official duties, except a state officer or employee performing official duties in making payments to state officers and employees. The receipt of wages or salary from an individual's non-state employer during a period of service as a state officer or employee shall not be construed as compensation for performance of official duties.

Based on information provided in your letter as well as your job descriptions for the USD 208 volleyball coach position and your current position as a Natural Resource Officer II for KDWP, you have indicated your current duties with the State do not include any of the services you would provide under the USD 208 contract. Thus, the situation you have described would not constitute a violation of K.S.A. 46-235.

In conclusion, the conflict of interest laws do not prohibit you from contracting with USD 208 to perform services as a volleyball coach while you are employed by KDWP as long as those services are different from your job duties as an employee of KDWP.

In addition, K.S.A. 46-241 provides that:

No state officer or employee shall disclose or use confidential information acquired in the course of his or her official duties in order to further his or her own economic interest or those of any other person.

This section is self explanatory. Confidential information obtained during your official duties with the State may not be used for your financial gain or the financial gain of another.

No oral or auction bids for the bonds will be considered. No bid for less than the entire principal amount of the bonds will be considered.

Bids will be accepted only on the official bid forms that have been prepared for the public bidding on the bonds, which may be obtained from the county clerk. Each bid for the bonds must be accompanied by a good faith deposit in the form of a qualified financial surety bond or certified or cashier’s check drawn on a bank located within the United States, each made payable to the order of the county and in an amount equal to 2 percent of the par amount of the bonds. Bidder qualification and bid requirements are set forth in the notice of bond sale distributed with the preliminary official statement.

Details of the Bonds

The bonds, in the principal amount of \$4,195,000, will be dated September 15, 2009, and will be issued as fully registered bonds in the denomination of \$5,000 or any integral multiples thereof. The actual principal amount issued and delivered is dependent upon the amount of prepaid special assessments. Should sufficient special assessment prepayments occur, the county will decrease the aggregate principal amount in \$5,000 increments to be deducted from the last maturities in the sole discretion of the county. The bonds shall initially be registered in the name of Cede & Co., as nominee of the Depository Trust Company, New York, New York, to which payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds will be made. Individual purchases of bonds will be made in book-entry form only. Purchasers will not receive certificates representing their interest in bonds purchased. The bonds will bear interest, payable as hereinafter set forth, at the rates specified by the successful bidder for the bonds.

Interest on the bonds will be payable semiannually on March 1 and September 1 in each year, commencing March 1, 2010.

Certain of the bonds are subject to redemption prior to their maturities as provided in the complete official notice of sale and preliminary official statement.

Payment of Principal and Interest

The Kansas State Treasurer will serve as the bond registrar and paying agent for the bonds, and the principal of the bonds will be payable upon surrender at the paying agent’s principal offices in the city of Topeka, Kansas. Interest will be paid by the mailing of a check, draft, or, in certain circumstances, electronic funds transfers, of the paying agent to the registered owners of the bonds.

Security for the Bonds

The bonds and the interest thereon will constitute general obligations of the county, and the full faith, credit, and resources of the county will be pledged to the payment thereof. The county is obligated to levy ad valorem taxes without limitation as to rate or amount upon all of the taxable tangible property within the territorial limits of the county for the purpose of paying the bonds and the interest thereon.

Delivery of the Bonds

The bonds, duly prepared, printed, executed and registered, will be furnished and delivered in book-entry form only at the expense of the county through the facilities of the Depository Trust Company, New York, New York, on or about September 29, 2009.

Legal Opinion

The bonds will be sold subject to the legal opinion of Robert J. Perry, Esq., Auburn, Kansas, bond counsel. Bond counsel’s approving legal opinion as to the validity of the bonds will be furnished and paid for by the county and delivered to the successful bidder upon delivery of the bonds. (Reference is made to the official notice of sale and preliminary official statement for a discussion of tax exemption and other legal matters.)

Financial Matters

The total equalized assessed valuation of the taxable tangible property within the county for computation of bonded debt limitations for the year 2008 is \$1,702,669,436. The total general obligation bonded indebtedness of the county as of the date of the bonds (including the bonds being sold) is \$58,040,000. The county has temporary notes outstanding in the amount of \$5,230,000, of which \$4,195,000 will be retired with the bonds offered herein.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment has received an application to expand the Cornejo & Sons, Inc. construction and demolition (C&D) landfill. The C&D landfill expansion would be on land south of and adjacent to the Cornejo & Sons, Inc. landfill located at 3299 Southeast Blvd., Wichita. The proposed landfill expansion would be constructed and operated in conformance with state solid waste regulations, accepting only C&D wastes as defined by Kansas statutes. The total area permitted for C&D waste disposal would increase from 24.5 acres to 26.5 acres; the closure elevation would increase from 1,315 feet to 1354 feet; and the landfill's disposal capacity would increase by about 400,000 cubic yards. The additional capacity would allow the landfill to continue to accept wastes until its December 10, 2010, last waste receipt date set by the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Department conditional use permit, CON2009-00003.

The Sedgwick County commissioners have certified that the application described herein is consistent with the county's solid waste management plan and local land usage. Additionally, the county commissioners have approved a reduction in the buffer distance between the site's southern and eastern property lines and the proposed disposal area. KDHE has reviewed the application and found it to be in conformance with state solid waste statutes and regulations.

KDHE is providing public notice of the intent to approve the proposed landfill expansion. However, a final decision to approve the expansion has not been made, and KDHE will consider information gathered during the public comment period before making a final decision. Request for Comments

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region VII, have received a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) hazardous waste Part A and Part B permit renewal application from Ash Grove Cement Company (Ash Grove) located at 1801 N. Santa Fe St., Chanute. The KDHE and the EPA are providing notice of their intent to renew a jointly issued RCRA hazardous waste treatment and storage permit to Ash Grove, the operator and owner of the facility.

The facility was originally permitted to store hazardous wastes in 1996 and assigned the EPA identification number KSD031203318; in 1998 this permit was modified to expand the facilities container and tank storage capacities; in 2000 the permit was modified when the facility replaced the old wet kiln system with the current dry process pre-heater/pre-calciner cement kiln; and in 2008 the permit was modified again when the facility added a bulk waste storage silo and conveyance system.

In October 1985, the state of Kansas received final authorization from the EPA to implement its own hazardous waste management program in lieu of the federal program except for the portions covered by the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) of 1984. The KDHE portion of the permit (Part I) will be issued under the authority of K.S.A. 65-3430 et seq. and K.A.R. 28-31-9, and the EPA portion of the permit (Part II) will be is-

sued under the authority of sections 3001(g), 3001(h), 3002 (b), 3004(d), 3004 (u) and (v), 3005, and 6001 of RCRA.

Part I of the permit will allow Ash Grove to receive hazardous waste via rail and over the road in both bulk and palletized containers from off-site generators and other hazardous waste processors; store a total of 190,000 gallons of liquid hazardous waste in five aboveground storage tanks; store a total of 196,864 gallons of solid hazardous waste in six container storage areas; store up to 300 cubic yards of bulk solid hazardous waste in an aboveground storage silo; conduct manual bulk container cleaning operations; and transfer hazardous waste not suitable for processing into a fuel to other RCRA-permitted facilities. The materials stored at the facility will include ignitable, corrosive, reactive, toxic and listed liquid or solid hazardous wastes. All storage tanks and container storage areas comply with 40 CFR Part 264 Subpart I, Subpart J, Subpart BB, Subpart CC and Part 270 requirements for container and tank storage areas. Emergency equipment is available at the facility and appropriate warning signs are posted on the perimeter fences. The EPA portion (Part II) of the joint permit will address the requirements of HSWA.

A copy of the administrative record, which includes the draft permit, the permit application and all information pertaining to this permit action, is available for public review August 31-October 16 during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, at the following locations:
