## Notice of Available Funding

The Kansas Housing Resources Corporation will be conducting the distribution of the 2012 HOME Rental Development funding application. Approximately \$1.4 million in funding is available for acquisition/rehabilitation and new construction of rental housing. CHDO operating funds also are available to those organizations applying for development funding. To be considered for funding, interested persons must submit an application request in writing to Cynthia Howerton, KHRC, 611 S. Kansas Ave., Suite 300, Topeka, 66603-3803, or [chowerton@kshousingcorp.org](mailto:chowerton@kshousingcorp.org). Completed applications must be delivered to the KHRC not later than 5 p.m. February 3.

Another change to this year's application will be an open question forum from January 3-20. All questions will be published and applicants notified of the Q&A. Two workshops will be conducted, one in person and one via teleconference, to clarify the expectations of each applicant. Workshop #1 will be held January 13 in Wichita (time and location to be determined), and Workshop #2 will be held via teleconference at 10 a.m. January 20 (call-in number will be forwarded to applicants).

The KHRC has updated the application this year and applicants should make sure they are utilizing the new form. CHDOs may submit more than one application each cycle, but may not request more than \$500,000 of development funds per development. The scoring criteria are discussed in the application guidelines.

If property will be acquired, either through purchase or donation, applicants must follow the acquisition guidelines for the HOME Program. Notices (available on the KHRC website) must be provided to the current prop-

erty owners. The environmental review section of the application guidelines and the environmental review chapter for the CHDO manual are online. Upon submission, do nothing related to the project, particularly acquisition (you can enter into an "option to purchase"), demolition, and site work.

**Notice of Pending Water Pollution  
Control General Permit**

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment has prepared a combined Kansas/NPDES Water Pollution Control General Permit for stormwater runoff from construction activities. This permit, when finalized, will replace the existing general permit.

A general wastewater permit is provided for those entities engaged in similar activities and discharging the same types of wastewater. The wastewater from these types of activities has a low public health and environmental risk. A general permit is placed on public notice once during the life of the permit and then is made available, without further public notice, to all persons for construction activities that meet the requirements of the permit. The permittees also are required to meet all other federal, state and local requirements, including local zoning ordinances.

Stormwater runoff from construction activity means the discharge from any conveyance that is used for collecting and conveying stormwater and that is directly related to discharges of stormwater from construction activities (e.g. clearing, grubbing, excavating, grading, etc.) that disturb a cumulative total of one acre or more or that are part of a larger common plan of development or sale that will disturb a cumulative total of one acre or more. The term does not include discharges from facilities or activities excluded or exempted from the Kansas/Federal Water Pollution Control program requirements.

New permittees are required to complete and submit the Notice of Intent along with the first year's permit fee of \$60 and will receive a signed and dated authorization from KDHE. To maintain the permit, the permittee is required to achieve and maintain compliance with the permit requirements, pay the annual permit fee and periodically review and update the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan.

Supporting documents include an Executive Summary, Notice of Intent form and instructions, Individual Lot Certification form, a Notice of Termination form, a Notice of Transfer of Ownership form, and Definitions and Acronyms. Request for Comments

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment is soliciting comments regarding two proposed air quality permits. Cornejo & Sons, LLC has applied for a construction permit in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-300 and a Class II operating permit in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-540. Emissions of particulate matter (PM), particulate matter with aerodynamic diameter less than or equal to 10 micrometers (PM<sub>10</sub>), nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>), carbon monoxide (CO), sulfur oxides (SO<sub>x</sub>, essentially SO<sub>2</sub>), hazardous air pollutants (HAPs), volatile organic compounds (VOCs), and greenhouse gasses (GHGs), including carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>), were evaluated during the permit review process. The purpose of a Class II permit is to limit the potential-to-emit for these pollutants to below major source thresholds.

Cornejo & Sons, LLC, 2060 E. Tulsa, Wichita, 67213, has proposed to install and operate a crushed stone processing facility located at 1499A Dove Road, Moline, 67353.

A copy of the proposed permits, permit applications, all supporting documentation and all information relied upon during the permit application review process is available for public review for a period of 30 days from the date of publication during normal business hours at the KDHE, Bureau of Air, 1000 S.W. Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, and at the KDHE Southeast District office, 1500 W. 7th St., Chanute. To obtain or review the proposed permits and supporting documentation, contact Lynette Bayless, (785) 291-3271, at the KDHE central office; and to review the proposed permit only, contact Doug Cole, (620) 431-2390, at the KDHE Southeast District Office. The standard departmental cost will be assessed for any copies requested.

Air, 1000 S.W. Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, 66612-1366. In order to be considered in formulating a final permit decision, written comments must be received before the close of business January 31.

A person may request a public hearing be held on the proposed permits. The request for a public hearing shall be in writing and set forth the basis for the request. The written request must be submitted to Sharon Burrell, Bureau of Air, not later than the close of business January 31 in order for the Secretary of Health and Environment to consider the request.

Notice Concerning Kansas/Federal Water Pollution Control Permits and Applications

A public hearing will be conducted at 10 a.m. Tuesday, February 28, in the fourth floor training room of the Kansas Department of Agriculture, 109 S.W. 9th, Topeka, to consider the adoption of proposed regulations.

This 60-day notice of the public hearing shall constitute a public comment period for the purpose of receiving written public comments on the proposed rules and regulations. All interested parties may submit written comments prior to the hearing to the Secretary of Agriculture, 109 S.W. 9th, 4th Floor, Topeka, 66612, or by e-mail at [leslie.garner@kda.ks.gov](mailto:leslie.garner@kda.ks.gov). Comments also may be made through the department's website at <http://www.ksda.gov>, under the proposed regulation. All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to present their views orally on the adoption of the proposed regulations during the hearing. In order to give all parties an opportunity to present their views, it may be necessary to request that each participant limit any oral presentation to five minutes.

These regulations are proposed for adoption on a permanent basis. A summary of the proposed regulations and their economic impact follows:

**K.A.R. 4-15-5** increases the live plant dealer licensing fee to \$80 per license.

**K.A.R. 4-15-6** removes the \$15,000 cap to align with the language in K.S.A. 2-2129(a).

Economic Impact Statement: The program expects to see an increase of \$41,920 of fees per fiscal year with the increase from \$60 to \$80 per license. A live plant dealer that imports, exports, or whose annual gross receipts are greater than \$10,000 will see a cost increase from \$60 to \$80 per license. Individuals or businesses that currently receive the license fee exemption and do not import or export live plants will not be affected. Removing the \$15,000 cap to the emergency pest fund will allow the department to manage the pest fund above \$15,000, which can be used, at the Secretary of Agriculture's discretion, in a plant pest emergency.

Any individual with a disability may request accommodation in order to participate in the public hearing and may request the proposed regulations and impact statements in an accessible format.
